Cartooning for Peace, the Memorial of Caen and the MGEN will inaugurate this new space on January 28, 2010.

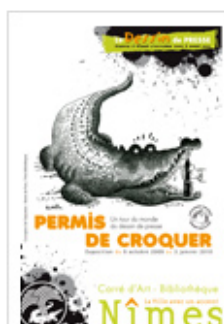
